### REGULAR CRIME CONTROL MEETING

#### Roll Call

President Alan Price called the Regular Meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and requested CCPD Board Secretary Margarita DeLeon to call roll, and then announced that the majority of the board members were present constituting a quorum of the Crime Control and Prevention District.

1. Consider Approval of the Minutes from July 25, 2019 Meeting.

**After careful review Board Member JoAnn Grammer made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 25, 2019 meeting, Board Member Brinda Rhodes seconded the motion which carried unanimously.**

#### Presentations

2. Crime Control Financial Reports for December 2020 presented by the Finance Director Krystal Crump.  
Finance Director Krystal Crump introduced the Financial Reports and stated that the December sales taxes are slightly up from the previous year. She informed the board that Enterprise sold 5 PD vehicles. The revenue from the sale of the vehicles will be going back to the CCPD Board which is approximately \$62K.

New Business to Discuss

3. Chief Bevering will update the CCPD Board on the current budget.

Chief Bevering presented a power point slide to the CCPD Board. He went on to explain that all the ammunition had been ordered for this year and the PD is waiting for it to arrive. Under Material and Supplies the radio ear pieces will be ordered as soon as the new radios are distributed to the officers. At the moment there has not been a need to order seat belt extenders since the cars from Enterprise currently come equipped with them. Under Contractual Services the PD did spend a one-time expense of \$7,400.00 for mold remediation for the property room. The yearly contributions to other Agencies like The Women's Center, Safe City Commission and Alliance for Children have been paid for this year. Lastly, there is a monthly transfer to the General Fund for the funding of eight officers.


