The Crime Control and Prevention District of the City of White Settlement, Texas, convened at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 09, 2019 with the following members present:

### REGULAR CRIME CONTROL MEETING

#### Roll Call

President Alan Price called the Regular Meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and requested CCPD Board Secretary Margarita DeLeon to call roll, and then announced that all the board members were present constituting a quorum of the Crime Control and Prevention District.

1. Consider Approval of the Minutes from April 04, 2019 Meeting.

**After careful review Board Member Brinda Rhodes made a motion to approve the minutes of the April 04, 2019 meeting, VP Board Member Pamela Clawson seconded the motion which carried unanimously.**

#### Presentations

2. Crime Control Financial Reports for March 2019 presented by the Finance Director Krystal Crump.  
Finance Director Krystal Crump introduced the Financial Reports and stated that according to the sales tax this month is actually trending 4.2% downward compared to our previous year. Due to Toys "R" Us and Del Taco closing down our current month is a lot less than normal. Del Taco is being replaced by another restaurant at the moment. The City should see partial sales tax for Chick Fil A in June and a full sales tax in July since they just opened.

New Business

3. Chief Bevering will discuss and answer the preliminary City of White Settlement CCPD Budget for FY2019-2020.

Chief Bevering went on to explain that the office supplies line items has been picked up by the city's general fund account and no longer funded by the CCPD Board since FY-2017. As it stands the PD is requesting \$8,600.00 for Rifle & Pistol Ammunition. Fire Range Budget line items are not needed this year. The Uniform Budget is being requested for \$17,300.00 to outfit 31 patrol officers (uniforms, badges, and vests).

The CCPD Board was informed that the PD will be going on the Fort Worth Radio System sometime in July or August. Our current radio system is about 8 years old and the parts are not being made available anymore.

Krystal Crump spoke to the board about the benefits of our City leasing vehicles thru Enterprise. At the moment a lot of our surrounding cities already lease vehicles thru Enterprise. Enterprise will be purchasing 3 Tahoe's, 2 Pick-up Trucks, and 1 Chevy Malibu within this year's budget for the Police Department.

**With there being no further discussion President Alan Price adjourned the meeting at 7:20 p.m.**


