#### Roll Call

1. Consider Approval of the Minutes from May 09, 2019 Meeting.

**After careful review VP Board Member Pamela Clawson made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 09, 2019 meeting, Board Member JoAnne Grammer seconded the motion which carried unanimously.**

#### Presentations

2. Crime Control Financial Reports for May 2019 presented by the Finance Director Krystal Crump.  
Finance Director Krystal Crump introduced the Financial Reports and stated that year to date our sales tax is actually trending 4% over what is need to hit our budget numbers.

New Business

3. Chief Bevering will discuss and answer the preliminary City of White Settlement CCPD Budget for FY2019-2020.

Chief Bevering informed the CCPD board that the PD did not receive the federal grant that they had applied for. Since the radios will lose the ability to communicate with our surrounding agencies the PD is looking into replacing them. The PD is looking into purchasing 38 portable radios for our officers and City Marshal's office. The plan in purchasing these radios with Motorola will be a 5 year lease payment plan with a 3 year warranty on the radios.

Krystal is working with Enterprise to get the final lease payments for the patrol units. Krystal will discuss the final lease payment amounts for the patrol vehicles at the next CCPD meeting.

In closing the CCPD board agreed to move their next meeting to July 11<sup>th</sup>, due to the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Holiday.



**With there being no further discussion President Alan Price adjourned the meeting at 6:18 p.m.**


