Triggered Source Monitoring and Reporting Violation: Groundwater Rule

The City of White Settlement\PWSID: 2200081 failed to collect the required number of triggered source bacteriological samples for fecal indicator monitoring of the groundwater system during January/2020 this monitoring is required by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's "Drinking Water Standards" and the federal "Safe Drinking Water Act," Public Law 95-523.

Triggered source samples are used to monitor water quality and indicate if the water is free of fecal indicator bacteria. Following a positive routine total coliform result in our distribution system, our water system is required to submit one triggered source sample for every active groundwater well source. Failure to collect all required triggered source samples is a violation of the monitoring requirements and we are required to notify you of this violation.

What is being done?

We have created the position of environmental specialist solely to work with TCEQ and governing entities involving the city. To help the city stay in compliance with these governing entities.
