The availability of this data is dependent on local agency timely and accurate submissions, which can be impacted by local agency resource constraints, system updates, and technical issues. As data is submitted, routine data validations are applied to ensure compliance with FBI and state-level reporting guidelines. The UCR data is a 'live' collection; meaning agencies can continue to update their incident data per their investigation findings, when arrests occur, for any corrections needed, and in response to data quality checks. As such, this report is a reflection of all the data currently contained within the TXDPS UCR System at the time of inquiry for the timeframe specified. Due to the active nature of this data, this report may not match data retrieved from the system at a different time of inquiry or data produced in yearly publications.
